

## **DUNFORD PARISH COUNCIL**

### **MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

**HELD ON THURSDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2019 AT 7.30 P.M.**

**AT THE PARISH COMMUNITY CENTRE**

Present: Cllrs A. Pestell (Chair), J. Smith and T. Singleton.

#### **1. Apologies**

Apologies were received from Councillors Whitehead and Armitage

#### **2. Declarations of pecuniary or non-pecuniary interest**

There were no declarations of interest with respect to any of the items on the agenda.

#### **3. Minutes of the meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

The minutes were agreed as an accurate record.

#### **4. Matters arising**

It was noted that the joint agreement between DPC and DPCA has now been rescinded. A new agreement is to be drawn up and the Constitution amended.

#### **5. Website/Facebook Page**

The new website is to be launched. Councillor Smith will update it with minutes and agendas from May 2019. Older minutes can be added on if required.

#### **6. Dunford Parish Community Association**

The new Committee is moving things forward and according to plan.

#### **7. Crowedge Play Area**

There is some minor repair work which needs doing. It was agreed to advertise for a handyman on the Facebook page.

#### **8. Planning Applications**

Concerns were expressed that DPC have not been made aware of a planning application in respect of Broadstones Equestrian. The land in question is being developed and additions being made over time, which has led to more development than originally agreed. Details have been sent to Ingbirchworth Parish Council, but not Dunford, despite an agreement that paper copies should be sent due to non-availability of broadband.

#### **9. Finance**

Monthly accounts were accepted and agreed.

#### **10. Correspondence**

Correspondence received was distributed to appropriate Councillors.

**11. Any other business**

The BT Broadband to the Community Centre is to be cancelled. This was originally agreed by the previous DPCA Committee.

A number of street lights are out in the area. All those from Woodroyd Hill Lane to Sheffield Road are out due to an accident at Victoria, together with four lights between Sledbrook Crescent and Hazlehead.

The gullies from Hazlehead to Sheffield Road need clearing out due to the recent flash floods.
